Training and Leadership:

The ongoing development of trained volunteers is a central component of the Junior League's mission. We fulfill this component of our mission through developing and hosting internal volunteer-focused training initiatives.

The New York Junior League provides volunteers with an opportunity to learn about relevant community issues and to develop philanthropically, professionally, and personally. In Fiscal Year 2018 we developed the potential of our volunteers through 17 trainings, which were attended by over 1,560 attendees. In addition to these workshops, the Junior League equips volunteers for leadership through Leadership Day and a series specialized training for chairs, treasurers, and the others committee officers.

The Junior League also provides leadership development training for the greater New York City community through our signature programs and trainings. The Junior League annually hosts the nationally recognized, award-winning Nonprofit Boards Clearinghouse (NPBC). NPBC trains individuals from the community to be effective nonprofit board members and introduces them to NYC nonprofit agencies through a structured placement process. The training course focuses on board roles and responsibilities, monitoring fiscal policies, and understanding development strategic plans, and fund development support. In Fiscal Year 2018, 85 people participated in the course and 68 nonprofit agencies provided placements and

The Junior League also hosts the Forum for Nonprofits, which is an annual half-day education conference open to Junior League volunteers and the general public.

Attendees address key issues facing both nonprofits and the communities they serve. Established in 2001, the Forum for Nonprofits features various expert-led workshops and panel discussion on topics such as volunteer retention, technology trends, best practices for recruitment, and training and utilizing social media in the nonprofit environment.

Line 4b Program Service Accomplishments Continued:

The Junior League has been a leader in identifying and responding to vital needs of New Yorkers since its founding in 1901, with particular focus on five areas describes in more detail below: Adult Education and Mentoring; Child Health and Welfare; Children's Education; City Impact; and Culture and the Arts. In 2018, more than 2,800 women volunteers contributed approximately 250,000 hours of service to better the lives of women and children in New York City. Through direct service, advocacy, and collaboration with more than 60 other community organizations, the Junior League embodies a positive force for change within the communities it serves.

- Child Health and Welfare programs provide mentors to establish a life-long support system that leads to continued success for at-risk youth. Volunteers use a positive approach and harness individual strengths to foster responsibility, self-esteem, and agency. We lead two signature programs to support this objective, Community Health Access Module Program (CHAMP) and Cooking and Health Education for Families (CHEF), as described in the following section.
- Children's Education programs provide young New Yorkers and their families with educational learning opportunities, workshops, and skill development to empower themselves and their communities, including tutoring in math, reading, and writing.
- City Impact programs undertake service projects to increase the impact of organizations on New York City. Volunteers build capacity by leading ad hoc volunteers for immediate and short-term assistance. Volunteers also renovate indoor facilities and outdoor parks as safe and beautiful spaces for surrounding communities. We lead two signature programs to support this objective, Playground Improvement Project (PIP) and Community Improvement Project (CIP), as described in the following section.
- Culture and the Arts programs bring arts education and appreciation to under-served New York City children and teenagers to encourage self- expression while building confidence and self-esteem. Volunteers provide exposure to art and music through robust visual and performing arts curricula and supplemental trips to see live performance and shows.

Signature Programs:

Community Health Access Module Program (CHAMP) is in its 23rd year of presenting preventive health education programs/workshops to the New York City Community.

Topics range from preventing childhood obesity and diabetes to stress management and domestic violence advocacy. During Fiscal Year 2018, Junior League volunteers presented 46 workshops for almost 140 clients.

Community Improvement Project (CIP) is in its 7th year of adopting a nonprofit facility such as a public-school classroom, a senior center, a library, or a community center for a dramatic physical makeover. In Fiscal Year 2018, volunteers renovated a science lab within the Harbor Science & Arts School. They focused on painting, installing new flooring, increasing storage space, and updating the electrical components of the room. We also added science tables, equipment, and technology for the students. Over 450 volunteer hours and \$60,000 in materials were invested.
