Position Summary:

The New York Junior League is seeking a current undergraduate- or graduate-level student to receive university credit for an internship with its Development team, for 2-3 days during the week throughout Fall 2019 semester. The Prospect Research Intern will identify, evaluate and profile individual, corporate and foundation prospects in support of the NYJL's development initiatives. The Prospect Research Intern will work to development a pipeline of new prospects and provide actionable next steps for the Development team's pipeline. The Intern will work directly with the Associate Director of Development to develop a numeric, weighted tracking system for prospects.

Responsibilities include:

- Proactively conduct research on individuals and institutions
- Interpret and evaluate research results; communicate analysis to Development team
- Work with the Associate Director of Development to identify pipeline gaps and work creatively and
 proactively to close the gaps by discovering new prospects and untapped potential within the current
 prospects pool
- Inform engagement strategies by translating data analysis into best practices for NYJL's highest givers
- Monitor, analyze and disseminate news regarding individual prospects, the economy, philanthropic trends, and the culture at-large that could impact NYJL's giving
- Update NYJL's Digital Cheetah donor database with specifications to reflect preferences and findings for Individual Giving
- Other duties as assigned
